


Work Card 2018 to 2019 Comparison

Total cards processed in 2018: 9,800 Total cards processed in 2019: 11,021


Overall 12% increase in work card applications

- Day N' Vegas- October




Unlicensed Activity 2018 to 2019 Comparison




2020 Work Card Applications

Active	Completed the work card process and their permanent card has been mailed to them.		
Provisional	They are in provisional status. We are waiting for their fingerprint results to determine whether they can be made active or if they need to be denied.		
Pending	Applications received and inputted awaiting to be made provisional.		
Withdrawn	The applicant was missing information not allowing us to make a proper determination, so their application was withdrawn.		
Denied	Their card was denied pursuant to NRS 648.1493.		



Highlights:

- 225 Pending:
 - 107 are pending because we are missing information
 - 118 investigators are still processing
- Third quarter comparison: 773 decrease. Q4 2019 was 2,687 applications




Highlights:

- 520 Pending:
 - 379 are pending because we are missing information
 - 141 investigators are still processing
- Comparisons:
 - 1,234 increase from Q1
 - 306 Decrease from June 2019






