1. **Public Comment**

However, prior to the commencement and conclusion of a contested case or a quasi-judicial proceeding that may affect the due process rights of an individual, the board will not consider public comment, pursuant to NRS 233B.126.

2. **Workshop**

The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on topics that may be addressed by amending Chapter 648 of NRS/NAC. The specific topic to be addressed is Assembly Bill 184 as presented during the 80th Legislative Session relating to security guards and requiring certain training.

3. **Public Comment**

The Board may discuss the matters not appearing on the agenda, but may not act on the matters at this meeting. If the Board desires, the matters may be placed on a future agenda for action.
