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3	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. Let's call the
4	meeting to order. This is a special meeting of the
5	Private Investigators Licensing Board.
6	Can we have roll call, please?
7	MR. INGRAM: Yes, sir.
8	Board Member Colbert?
9	BOARD MEMBER COLBERT: Here.
10	MR. INGRAM: Board Member Nadeau?
11	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: Here.
12	MR. INGRAM: Board Member Nixon?
13	BOARD MEMBER NIXON: Here.
14	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: And Chairman Zane?
15	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Here.
16	MR. INGRAM: Ray Flynn will not be attending
17	today.
18	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Item number two on the
19	agenda is a call for a public comment. Is there anyone
20	in the audience that would like to give public comment
21	at this time? Anybody in the north?
22	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: No.
23	BOARD MEMBER COLBERT: No.
24	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Anybody in the south?
25	Nobody here. Okay. Item number three, anyone

giving testimony today would need to be sworn in at this 1 2 time. Are we anticipating any testimony today? MS. BORDELOVE: No. It's not an evidentiary 3 hearing, so. 4 BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. With that in mind, 5 then we'll go to number four, settlement agreement 6 7 proposal, PILB v. ESI Security Services. Who's leading off? 8 MR. CAMPBELL: Rick Campbell here on behalf of 9 ESI, along with Mr. Hendi. 10 MS. BORDELOVE: I don't have a whole lot to go 11 into. I believe, the Board received the settlement 12 13 agreement ahead of time and has had a chance to review it. I think, I can speak at least on behalf of -- it is 14 15 the Board that would be recommending it be accepted. And, I quess, that's in the case of ESI as well, but 16 I'll let Rick Campbell speak to that. I'm available 17 here for any questions you may have with respect to the 18 agreement or any aspects relating to it. 19 20 BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Do we have appearance of 21 Board counsel on the record? MR. DETMER: I apologize. Mike Detmer from the 22 Attorney General's Office acting as Board counsel. 23 24 BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. Thank you. 25 Did we miss anybody?

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1	MR. DETMER: I think, that's it.
2	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Thank you.
3	Mr. Campbell, do you have anything to say?
4	MR. CAMPBELL: No, I'm here to answer any
5	questions. Ms. Bordelove and I and the parties have
6	negotiated this a couple weeks ago, and then we're
7	working on fine-tuning the language, and I think we have
8	a good agreement.
9	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Thank you, sir.
10	Do we have Board questions regarding the agenda
11	item?
12	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: I have no questions.
13	Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I've reviewed the stipulated
14	agreement, and I have no questions.
15	BOARD MEMBER COLBERT: Nor do I, sir.
16	BOARD MEMBER NIXON: I don't.
17	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. As usual, I'll be
18	the stick-in-the-mud here. As I understand it, the
19	settlement incorporates the attorney's fees from the
20	prior settlement agreement. Is that correct?
21	MS. BORDELOVE: No.
22	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: No. So the attorney's
23	fees specified here would not be those that were
24	inclusive of the 2016 settlement agreement?
25	MS. BORDELOVE: Right. This is completely

1	separate from the 2016 agreement. The 2016 agreement's
2	mentioned in here because it's kind of giving the
3	history. But the attorney's fees listed in here are to
4	be paid, I guess, in addition or separately from
5	anything in the 2016 agreement.

BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. The only reason 6 7 that I raised that is I wanted to make sure that the record was clear that -- I don't know that it's been 8 resolved or not, but a few months ago, I was made aware 9 that there was some issue regarding services of the 10 counsel on the other case, this 2016 case, and whether 11 or not there were some fees owed, since they were 12 13 awarded. And there was a -- I was contacted because the 14 attorney, Raelene Palmer, was not getting it resolved with the Attorney General's Office because of a lack of 15 communications one way or the other. And at the time --16 and, like I say, this was several months ago. It may be 17 all resolved by now. I have no idea. 18

MS. BORDELOVE: I think, any dispute that that might be is between, I think, her and the Board but isn't in relation to ESI, because they paid the fees under the 2016 agreement to the Board.

BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. That gives me the clarity to that one. That's the only thing I had to raise on the issue.

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1	Any other Board questions, comment?
2	Entertain a motion.
3	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: Mr. Chair?
4	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Yes, sir.
5	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: Let me make sure I make
6	this appropriately. But I would move that the Board
7	accept the Stipulation for Settlement of Disciplinary
8	Action Agreement.
9	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: We have a motion. Do we
10	have a second?
11	BOARD MEMBER COLBERT: Second.
12	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. We have a motion
13	and a second. Any Board comment or question regarding
14	the motion?
15	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: No, but I would like to
16	check with counsel and make sure that that was the
17	appropriate motion.
18	MR. DETMER: The motion was fine. But we do
19	have to be certain that the settlement agreement itself
20	is made part of the record where it be incorporated by
21	reference.
22	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: Thank you.
23	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Now, as I understand the
24	motion, in the event that unlike the previous
25	settlement agreement that we had, in the event that, oh,

1	let's say, ESI doesn't pay the fees due by the last day
2	of December, that that isn't considered a disciplinary
3	action for any further issue, that just goes to
4	collections, right?
5	MS. BORDELOVE: I mean it could be potentially,
6	if they weren't to pay amounts, it could be potentially
7	considered a breach, I would think. But we also could
8	just go to collections on it. We attempted to make the
9	payment date to be clear
10	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Yes.
11	MS. BORDELOVE: in this agreement. That was
12	intentional. And so, hopefully, we don't have any
13	issues on that. But if we do, I guess that I I don't
14	know if you want to speak to this at all, Rick. It
15	would be my understanding, if the payment dates were
16	missed, that could potentially be considered a breach.
17	But the agreement does also allow to us proceed in
18	collections, and that route might just be
19	MR. CAMPBELL: Chairman Zane, it's unlike the
20	2016 stipulation whereby a late payment was considered a
21	breach that was, that could lead to disciplinary action.
22	It wasn't worded this way. It was really worded such
23	that if Mr. Hendi doesn't pay in time, then collection
24	actions are the remedy to go after him.
25	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. Thank you.

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1	MR. CAMPBELL: Because all of the underlying
2	notices of violation or court cases are all being
3	dismissed as part of the consideration and payment of
4	the attorney's fees and fines. So there is no, there
5	are no more underlying violations or court cases left
6	after the stipulation is approved.
7	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Okay. Thank you.
8	Any other Board questions on the motion?
9	All in favor, say "aye."
10	(Board members said "aye.")
11	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Any opposed, say "no."
12	It carries unanimous.
13	Okay. Do we have any Board comment on future
14	agenda items?
15	Hearing none, is there any public comment now
16	that we're done with one through five? Any public
17	comment in the north?
18	BOARD MEMBER NADEAU: Nothing here.
19	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: No public comment in the
20	south.
21	I move we adjourn.
22	BOARD MEMBER COLBERT: Second.
23	BOARD CHAIRMAN ZANE: Thank you all.
