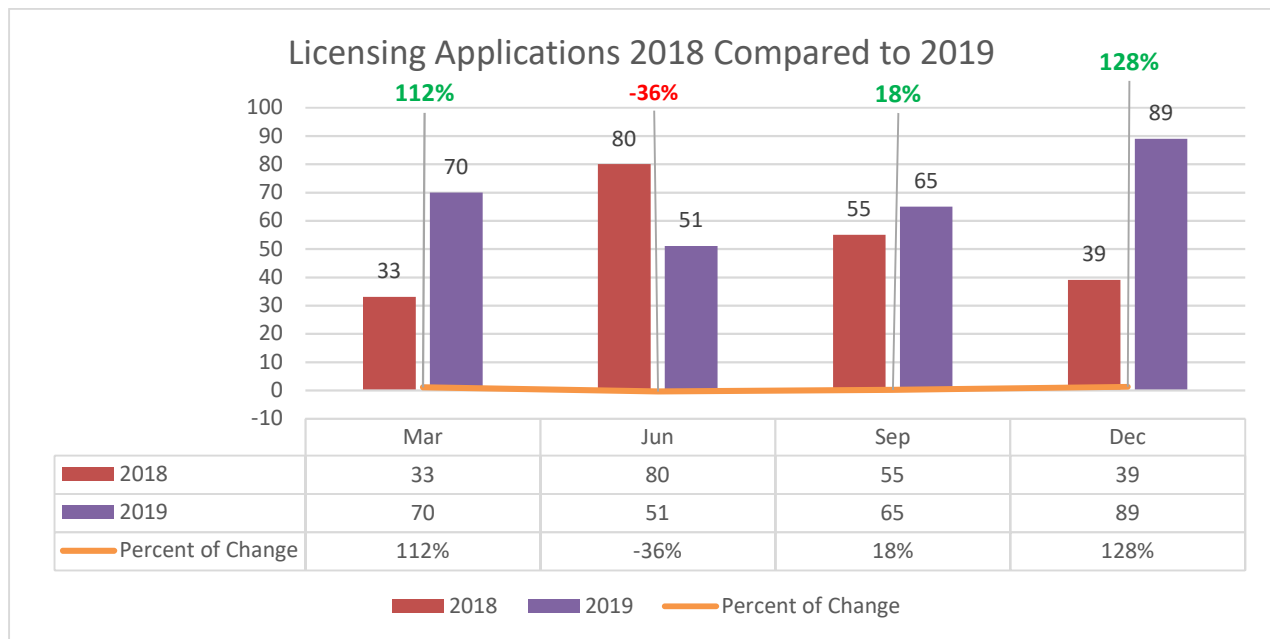
### Licensing 2018 to 2019 Comparison

## Work Card 2018 to 2019 Comparison

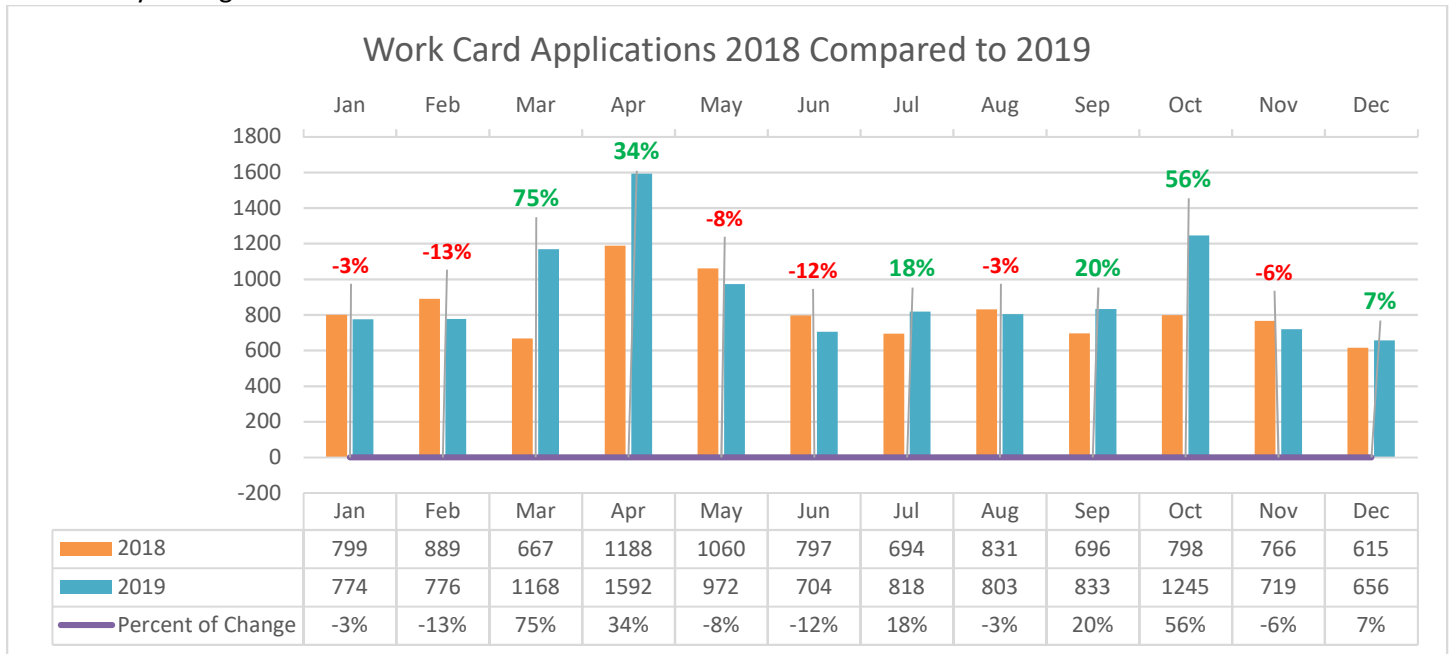
**Total cards processed in 2018:** 9,800

**Total cards processed in 2019:** 11,021

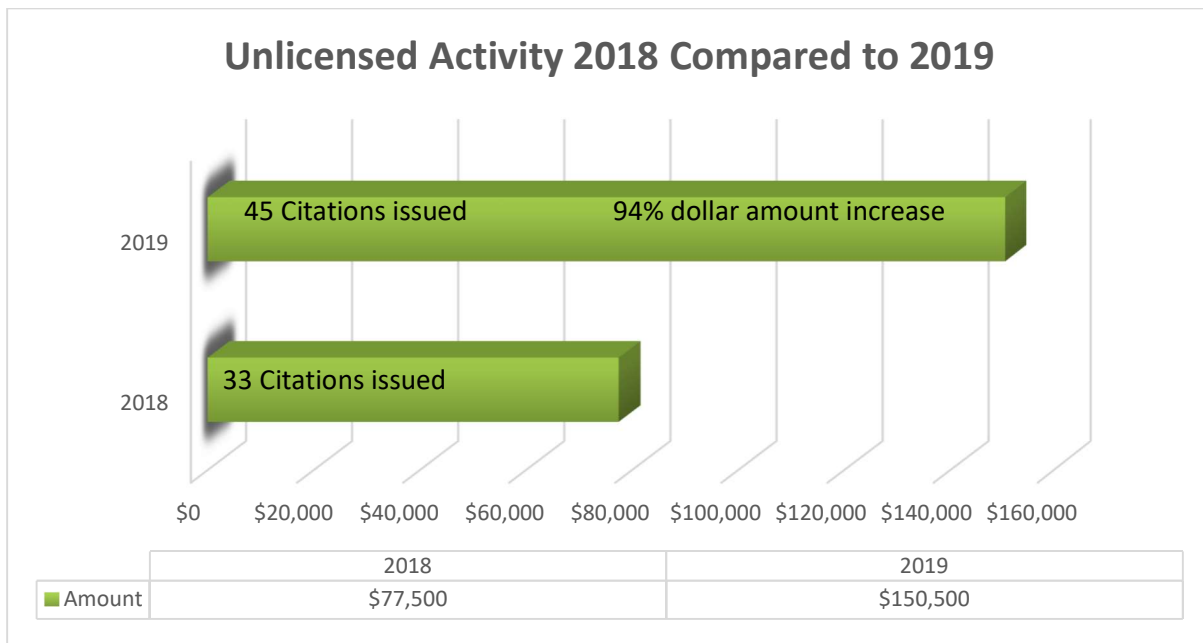
**Overall 12% increase in work card applications**

- Day N’ Vegas- October



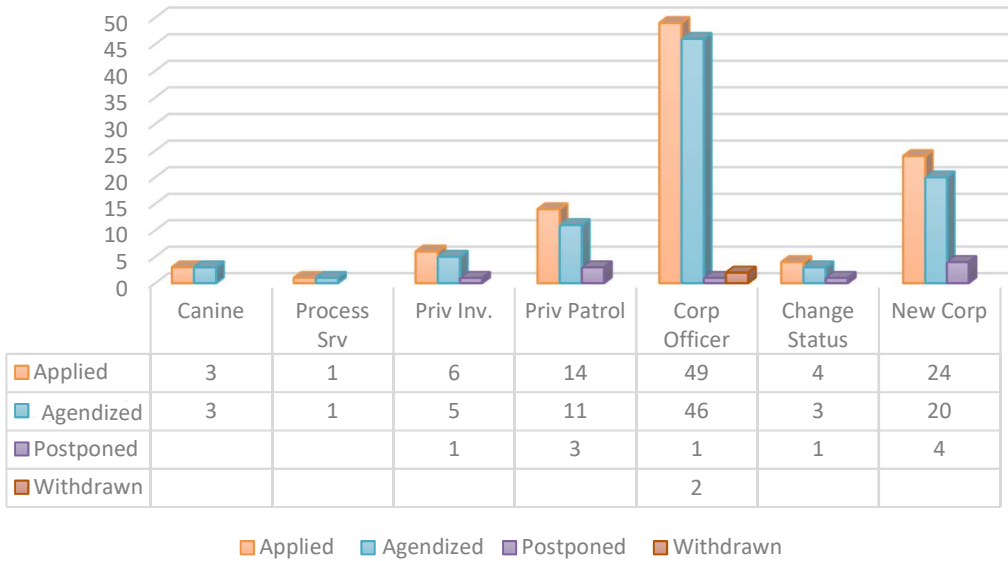
## Unlicensed Activity 2018 to 2019 Comparison

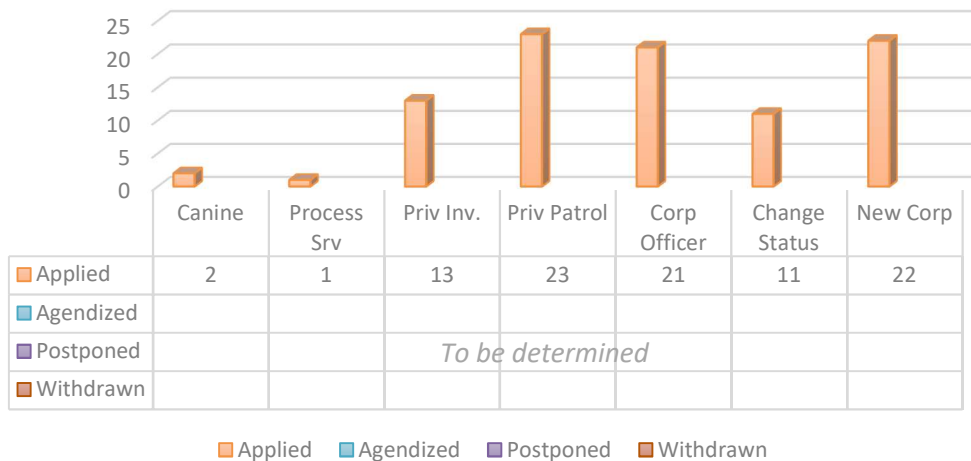

Licensee Application June 2020 Board



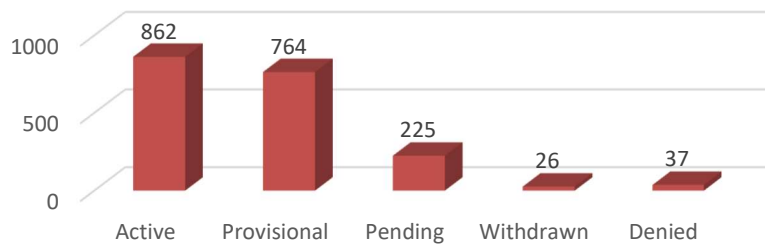

# 2020 Work Card Applications

<b>Active</b>	Completed the work card process and their permanent card has been mailed to them.
<b>Provisional</b>	They are in provisional status. We are waiting for their fingerprint results to determine whether they can be made active or if they need to be denied.
<b>Pending</b>	Applications received and inputted awaiting to be made provisional.
<b>Withdrawn</b>	The applicant was missing information not allowing us to make a proper determination, so their application was withdrawn.
<b>Denied</b>	Their card was denied pursuant to NRS 648.1493.

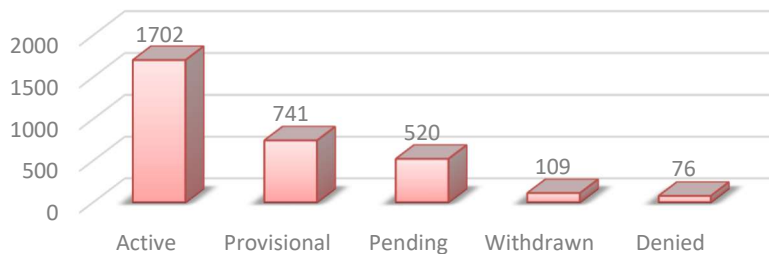
1,914 Work Cards Processed from Dec 1, 2019 to Feb 14, 2020

3,148 Work Cards Processed from to Feb 14, 2020 May 29, 2020



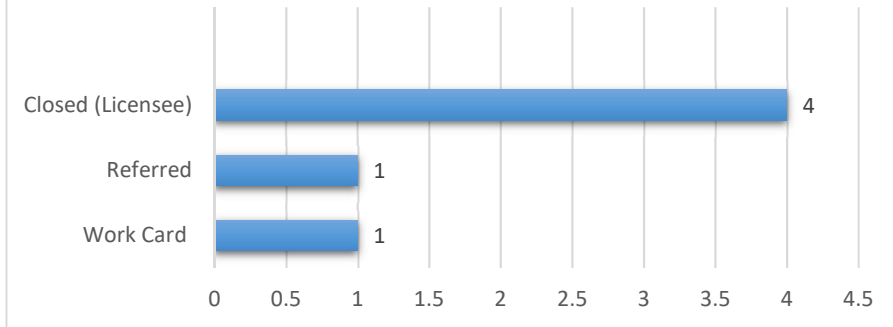
### Highlights:

- **520 Pending:**

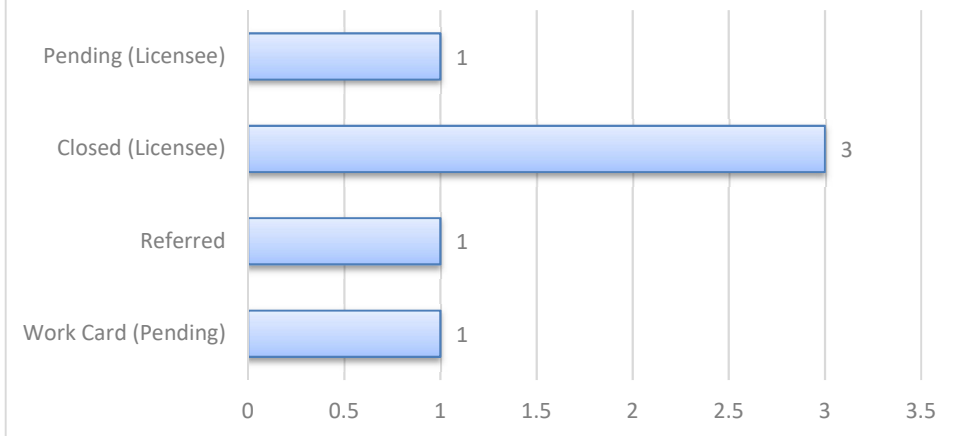
## Outcome of Complaints Dec 2019 to Feb 2020

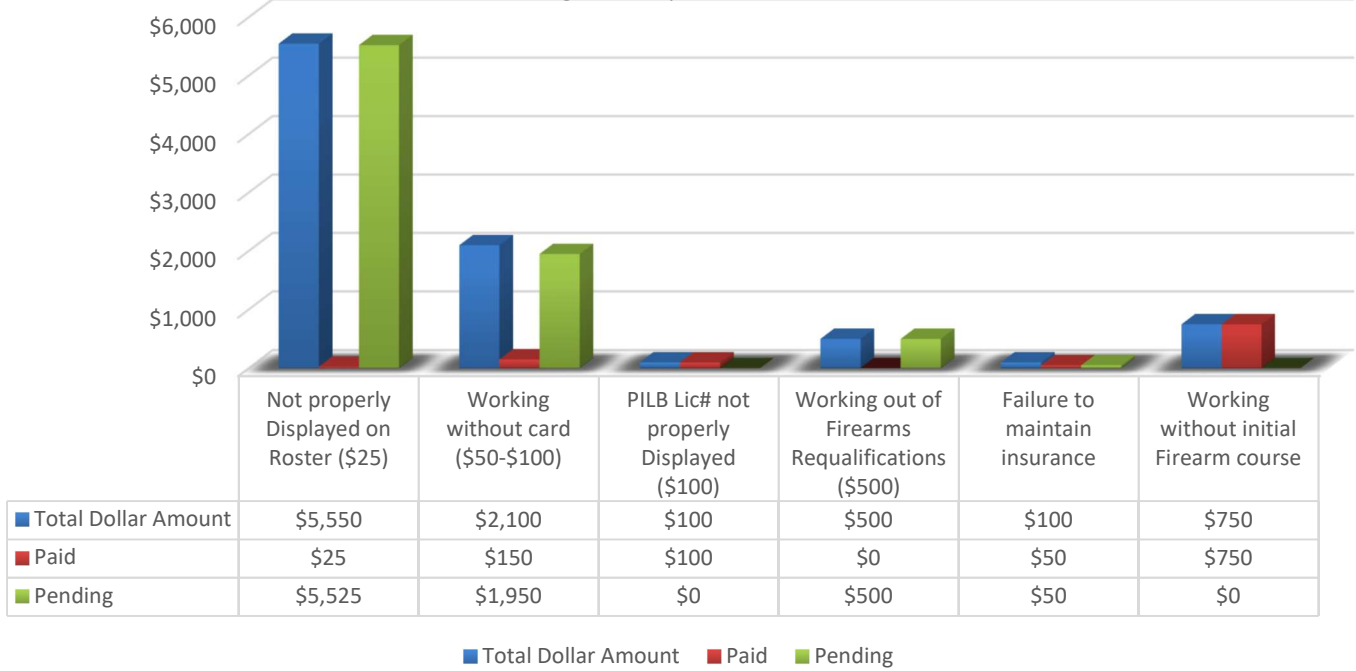

## Violations issued to License Holders Dec. 2019 to Feb. 2020

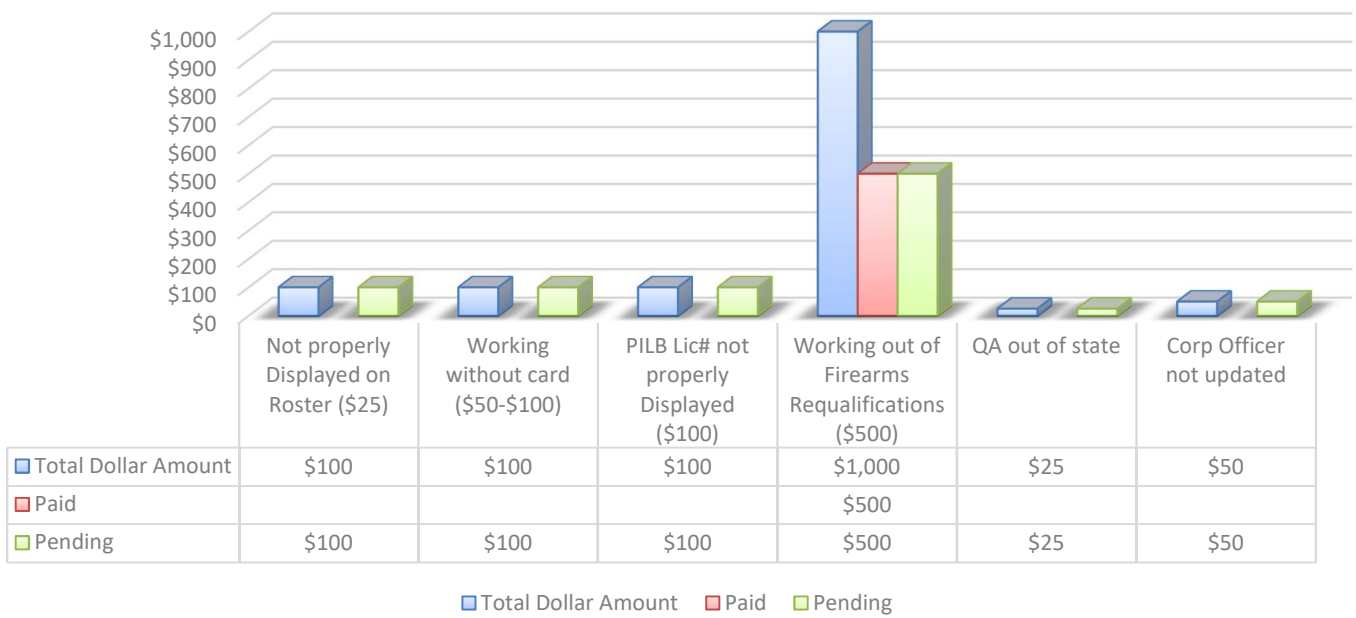
**A total of 9 licensees received violations**

An Audit during this time period affected the violation dollar amounts

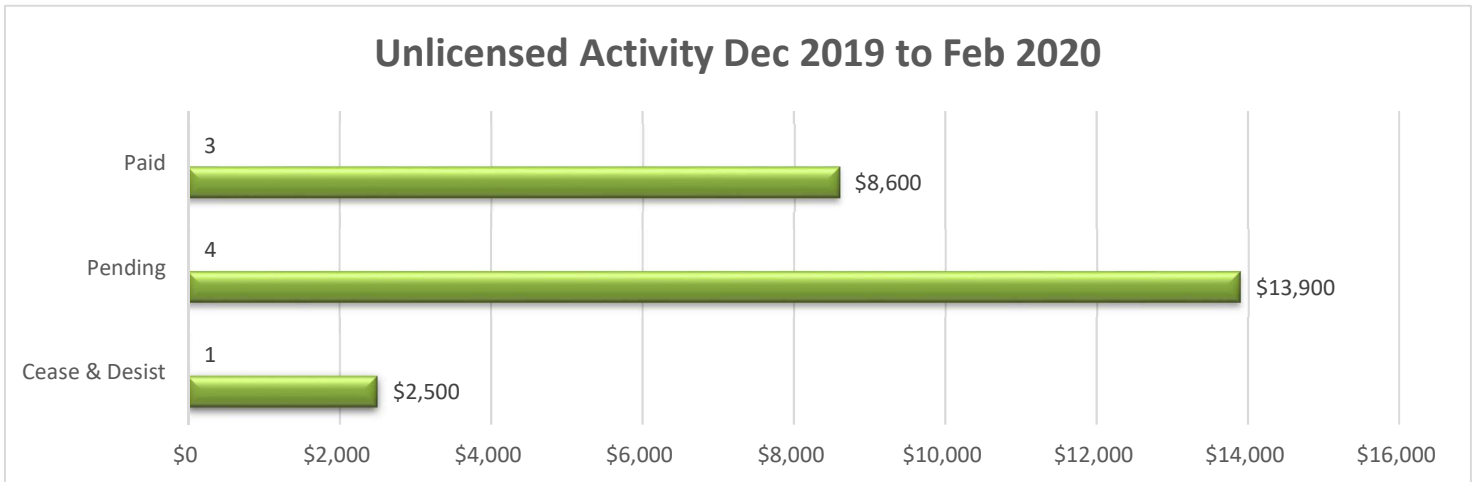


## Violations issued to License Holders February 2020 to June 2020

**A total of 4 licensees received violations**

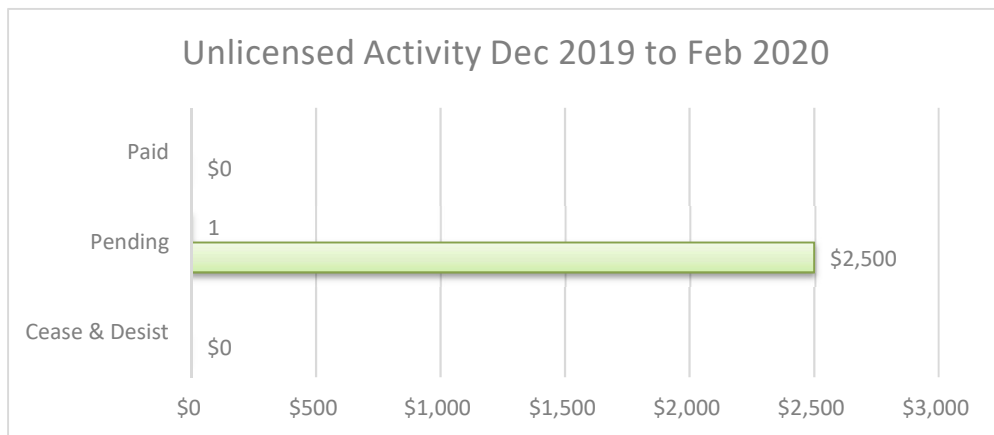
